Typical of the many immigrants who came to Hawai'i in the late 1800s and early 1900s, my father worked for the sugar plantation and we had a typical plantation worker lifestyle growing up. This meant a life of hard work and hardship.

Not unlike other immigrants, my parents' life goal was to establish the values of work and education in their children, and to sacrifice for their children's future.

I am an Army veteran, as are my two brothers. This was a time when most American boys did serve. After serving in the military as a medic, I was able to attend and graduate from Southern Oregon University with BS in Education and an MS in
