THIS WEEK: United Service Organizations

Our guest speaker this week is Jodi Brissette, who will provide information on the USO and what they are doing in Hawai'i.



The USO provides programs, entertainment and services at more than 180 USO locations worldwide, including Afghanistan, Djibouti, Kuwait, United Arab Emirates, Germany, Italy, Japan, Iraq, South Korea and the United States.

In 2014, USO centers were visited more than 7 million times by service members and their families. USO centers provide a warm and comforting place where service members can connect to loved ones via Internet or phone, play a video game, catch a movie, have a snack or just put their feet up and relax.

Currently, the four USO centers in Afghanistan collectively average more than 25,000 visits a month while our two centers in Kuwait collectively average more than 39,500 visits monthly.

The USO is opening several new locations this year, including centers in Alaska, San Antonio MEPS, two locations at Fort McCoy, Wisconsin, and several USO Transition 360 Alliance sites.
