becoming overwhelmed. Any young dog is at high risk of dying especially those under 6 months who have immature immune systems.

We have a 16 week old Irish Wolfhound puppy, Sassy who flew in from AU a couple weeks ago. Due to this and after consulting with our vet team, we are cancelling all tours and visits to 3RR. The risk to Sassy is just too high to even consider it. Parvo is highly contagious and can be transported on feet or car tires that a dog peed on.



THE PAU HANA THAT WAS SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 28TH IS CANCELLED! Please read the note from Ann:

Aloha All,

We are going to have to postpone due to an outbreak of parvo in the community. This began yesterday with one of the puppies I was shipping to a mainland rescue dying in the Orchidland shelter. Today 3 other dogs we were going to fly have died in both Kona and Orchidland. The local vets are swamped and some are turning away parvo cases due to not having enough space or staff. They are
